**GCC.** 4 out of 7 GCC indices advanced over last week. The Abu Dhabi ADX lost 1.53% over the past week, to finish at 2526.53. The losses were led by the consumer, construction and real estate sectors, which declined by 5.93%, 6.87% and 8.31% respectively. The industrial sector index was the lone bright spot, advancing just over 3%. The Dubai DFM retreated 2.88% over the week to finish at 1605.51. 7 out of 9 sector indices declined, with only the financial investment sector able to post a gain. The Bahraini BHSE gained 0.94% over the week, to end at 1596.04. The commercial bank sector index lost less than 1%, while the service sector posted a 1.65% gain. The KWSE increased 1.85% over last week with 7 out of 9 sector indices posting gains. The industrial sector posted the biggest gain, advancing 4.71%. The Qatari DSM 20 index gained over 5% as all sector indices advanced. The services sector index posed the biggest gain, increasing by 9.91%. The Saudi TASI surged 7.83% upwards as all its sector indices posted gains and 120 stocks increased to only 5 stocks retreating. The insurance, cement, petrochemical and hotel indices all increased by double digit percentages. The Omani MSM 30 posted a loss of 2.54% to finish the week at 5128.88.

**Rest of MENA.** The Egyptian CASE index gained over 4% to finish the week at 5191.34. The Lebanese BLOM treaded water, posting only a slight 0.04% gain. The Jordanian ASE declined 2.03% to 2736.50.

**Commodities.** WTI crude futures ended the week up 3.02% to end at \$51.12/b as global stock markets gain and consumer confidence increases amidst signs that the worst of the global economic crisis has passed. Natural gas futures ended the week down, by 2.58%, to finish at \$3.32/MMBtu, as supply continues to exceed demand. Gold finished at \$888.20, down 1.78%.

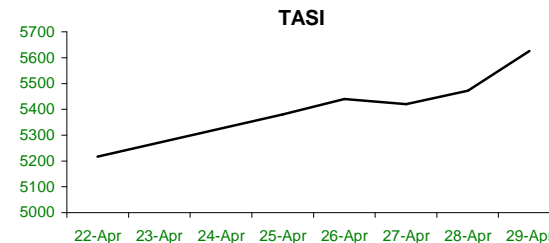
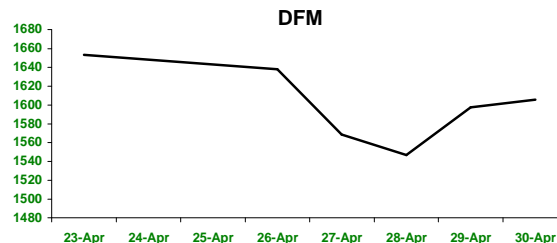
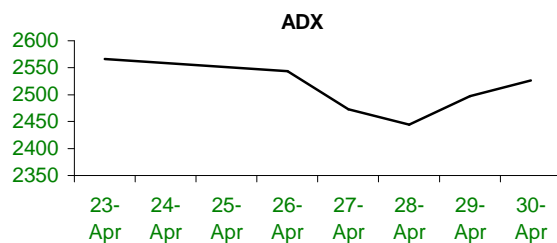
- Dubai has the most expensive average residential property prices out of 59 cities in 34 emerging countries according to REIDIN.com. Dubai's average price was USD7000 per square metre as of February 2009. (ADCB)
- **US GDP fell at a 6.1% annual pace in the first quarter of 2009. It had contracted 6.3% in the fourth quarter of 2009, according to the US commerce department. (Bloomberg)**
- The IMF believes that remittances, from expatriate workers in the UAE, will rise again in 2009. In 2008 workers sent home a record USD10b from the UAE. (ADCB)
- **King Abdullah of Jordan announced that an USD2.5b railway project would begin this year. The railway is expected to cross 1,600km across Jordan. (MenaFN)**
- An analyst working at Al Mal Capital estimated that UAE telecommunications companies added thousands of new subscribers in the first quarter of 2009, indicating a net-inflow of expatriates. (MenaFN)
- **The UAE Federal government is readying its final plans regarding the restructuring of Tamweel and Amlak. The plans will be revealed in the next few weeks. (MenaFN)**
- Saudi Arabia is attempting to convince vehicle and consumer good manufacturers to set up factories in the Kingdom. Saudi Aramco claims the government is in talks with a European car builder about constructing a plant in Saudi Arabia. The country has also signed a MoU with a Japanese Truck maker. (MenaFN)

- **Sorouh posted a first quarter profit of AED125.45m versus AED361.47m in the same period last year, a 65% decline. (Bloomberg)**
- Dubai Financial Market's net income for Q1 fell 81% to AED58.5m compared to AED314.4m from the same period last year. (Bloomberg)
- **Aldar's Q1 net income fell 35% to AED889m from AED1.37b in the same period last year. (Bloomberg)**
- First Gulf Bank posted an 11% increase in its Q1 profits compared to a year ago. Net income rose to AED750m, while total revenue increased to AED1.32b. (Bloomberg)
- **RAK Properties' first quarter net income was AED70m, a decline from AED114m from the same period last year. (Bloomberg)**
- Bank of Sharjah reported a 24% increase in net income for the first quarter. Net income increased to AED109m from AED88m last year. (Bloomberg)
- **Finance House posted a net income of AED30.9m in the first quarter versus AED126.7m in the corresponding period last year. (Bloomberg)**
- Dubai Islamic Bank's first quarter profits fell 33% to AED370m from the Q1 2008. (Bloomberg)
- Union National Bank announce first quarter profits of AED303.94m, a 10% drop from the same period last year. (Bloomberg)



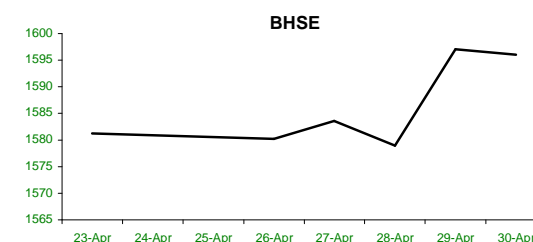
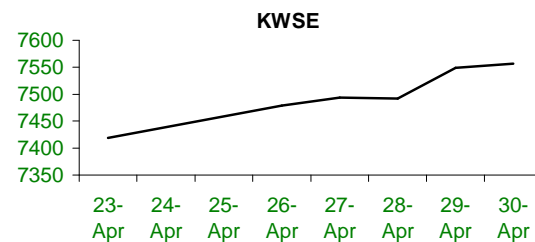
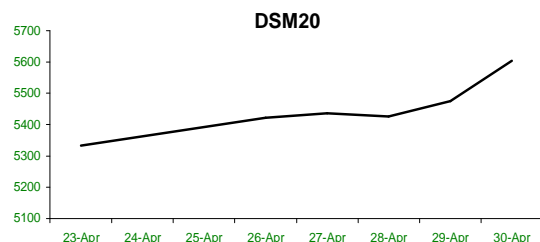

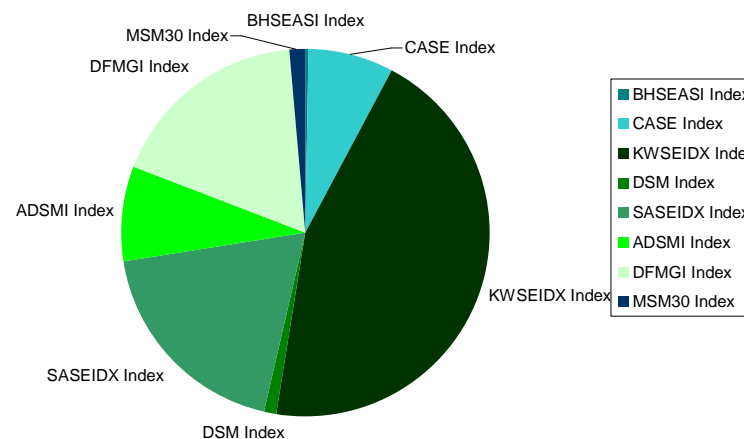
